Gentlemen:

I should like to report to you that the services of Fernandina Cable Television Company can only be described as arbitrary, inadequate, and underhanded. I am an absentee landlord of a condominium apartment at Amelia Island Plantation, Beachwalker #1181, and as such assumed the T.V. cable connection when I purchased the property over one year ago.

While we were away for a 3 1/2 week vacation in December, the December bill came for the cable company, which was paid (admittedly rather late) on December 31, 1981. Upon examining my cancelled check, I note that it passed through the banking system on January 11, 1982. According to Mitzie at the cable company office, our cable was disconnected on that same date of January 11, at which time they should already have had our check in hand. Incidentally, our January payment was made on January 5; and I note that the check passed the bank on January 13.

I was not advised of this disconnect of January 11 until our friends who are staying at our apartment commented that they were not getting television when they arrived on February 26. In addition, I am now advised that I will have to pay a \$25 re-connect fee in order to get this service once again. I have no other recourse at this time other than to pay this fee.

I suggest that the Board of Commissioners of Nassau County review the quality of service that Fernandina Cable Television Company provides for its subscribers. Thank you.

We are presently surveying our property and the right-of way; as soon as the maps are finished I will forward a copy to you.

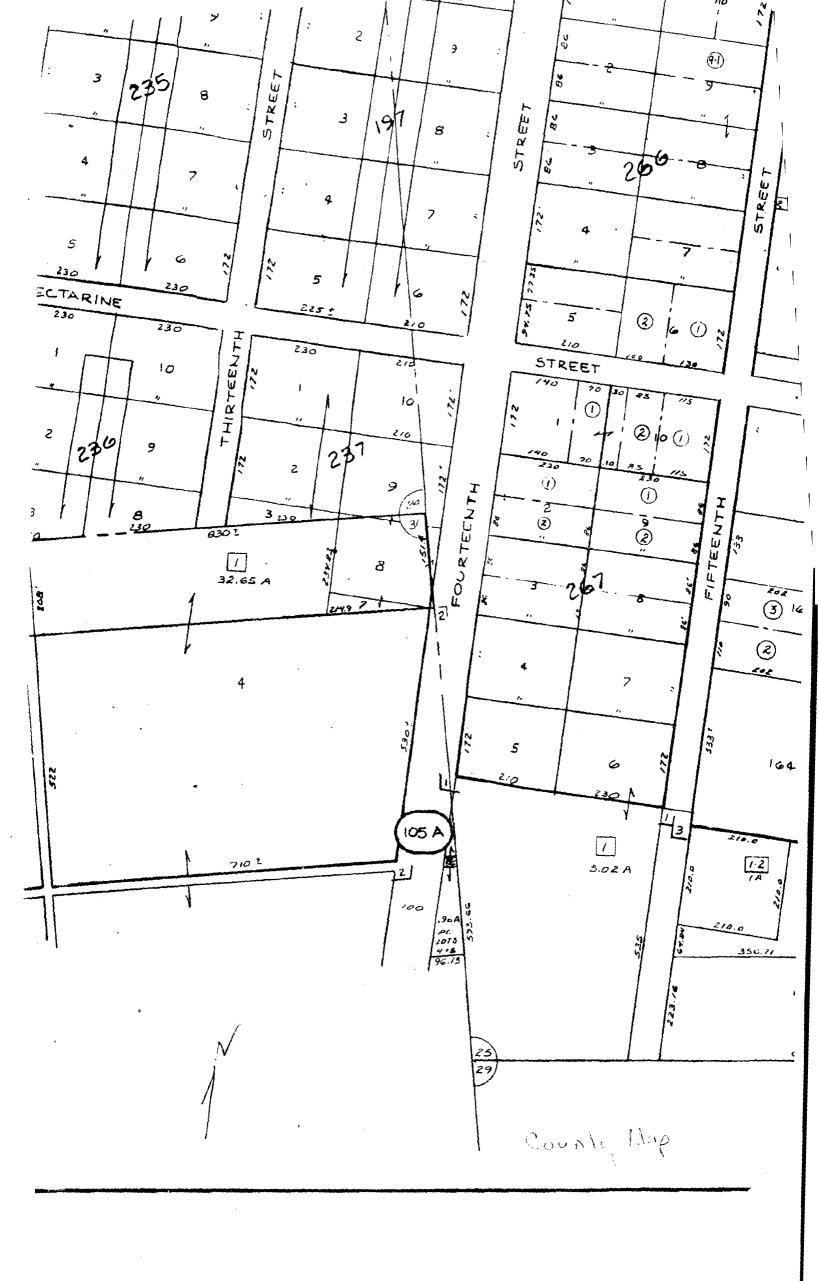
I have enclosed a copy of the county map showing the right-of-way.
