Gentlemen:

This letter, when acknowledged and accepted by the Board, will serve as a memorandum of agreement between the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida, and ITT Rayonier, Inc. granting the Board the privilege of removing clay and other borrow material from a certain borrow located on the Old Dixon Place, West of the Lessie Road, approximately one mile North of S.R. S-107 and would be located in the approximate area of Section 2, Township 3 North, Range 25 East; Section 42, Township 3 North, Range 25 East and Section 35, Township 4 North, Range 25 East.

The removal from this pit will be confined to an area outlined to the County Engineer by A. J. Jones, Tract Manager, Rayonier's Nassau Forest.

It is mutually agreed that the Board, through the County Engineer, will organize and rework the existing pit area feasible to Nassau County equipment. The original term of agreement is for a period of 12 months from the date of approval and acceptance by the Board. Annual lease payment by the Board will be \$100.00, payable in advance. This agreement may be extended on a year to year basis by a mutual agreement of the two parties and an additional annual payment of \$100.00.
