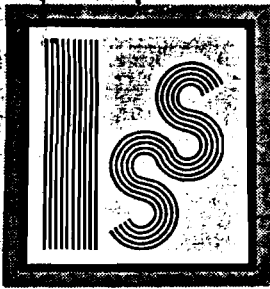

Dear Mr. Chairman:

This office expects to begin receiving ambulances for disbursement to counties by October 17, 1978. While we will not be able to inform you of an exact delivery date at this time, we need to clarify procedures to be followed when you are notified of your delivery time.

1. Inclusive with this letter, you are being sent a check representing 50% of your vehicle(s) purchase price.
2. You will be notified at least three days prior to your delivery so that you can obtain a county warrant for the full purchase price. YOU MUST BRING THIS CHECK WHEN YOU ACCEPT YOUR VEHICLE IN TALLAHASSEE.
3. You may inspect the vehicle with the factory representative and a member of the EMS office in Tallahassee. We will certify that the vehicle meets contract specifications. Acceptance or rejection beyond that will be at the discretion of your representative and the vendor's representative.
4. Upon acceptable transfer of each vehicle, you will receive:
  - a. Manufacturer's Statement of Origin.
  - b. Check to Division of Motor Vehicles for title application fee.
  - c. Operator's Manual, Warranties, Schematics.

Acceptance and Agreement

Conditions of Agreement. The applicant understands and agrees to the following conditions:

1. Reports. The subgrantee shall submit, at such time and in such form as may be prescribed, such reports as the Section may reasonably require, including periodic financial reports, quarterly progress reports, and final financial and narrative reports.
2. Responsibility of Subgrantee. The subgrantee must establish fiscal control and fund accounting procedures which assure proper disbursement of and accounting for, grant funds. All moneys spent on this project will be disbursed in accordance with provisions of the project budget as said budget was approved by the Section.
3. Compliance with Sec. 287.055, Florida Statutes. The subgrantee, when applicable, agrees to satisfy all requirements provided in Section 287.055, Florida Statutes, better known as the "Consultants' Competitive Negotiation Act".
4. Written Approval of Changes. Subgrantees must obtain prior written approval from the Section for major project changes. These include (a) changes of substance in project activities, designs, or research plans set forth in the approved application; (b) changes in the project director or key professional personnel identified in the approved application; and (c) changes in the approved project budget.
5. Audit. GHSC, NHTSA, FHWA, and the Auditor General of the State of Florida, or any of their duly authorized representatives, shall have access for purpose of audit and examination of any books, documents, papers, and records of the subgrantee, and to relevant books and records of subgrantees and contractors, as provided by the provisions of section 402(a) of the Highway Safety Act of 1966, Public Law 89-564, as amended.
6. Equal Employment Opportunity. No person shall, on the grounds of race, creed, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be refused the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under subgrants awarded pursuant to P.L. 89-564, or any project, program, activity, or subgrant supported by such requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and all applicable requirements pursuant to the regulations of the Department of Commerce (Title 15, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 8, which have been adopted by the Department of Transportation).



In addition, they must advise the EMS office, in writing, that they no longer wish to participate in the grant program for this year.

### Special Conditions Item #7

- a) Type of vehicle(s) purchased must be as specified by the EMS office
- b) Matching funds will only be granted to those eligible counties purchasing vehicles off the "State Contract"
- c) Purchase order(s) for the full purchase price must be received by the EMS office no later than 5 pm June 26, 1978.
- d) All vehicles will be delivered FOB Tallahassee
- e) Vehicle will be jointly inspected by EMS office and County Representative. Any discrepencie, noted will be pointed out to the County Representative and he will decide if the county wishes to accept the vehicle.'
- f) Vehicle title will not be turned over to the county until a check for the full purchase price is received by the EMS office.

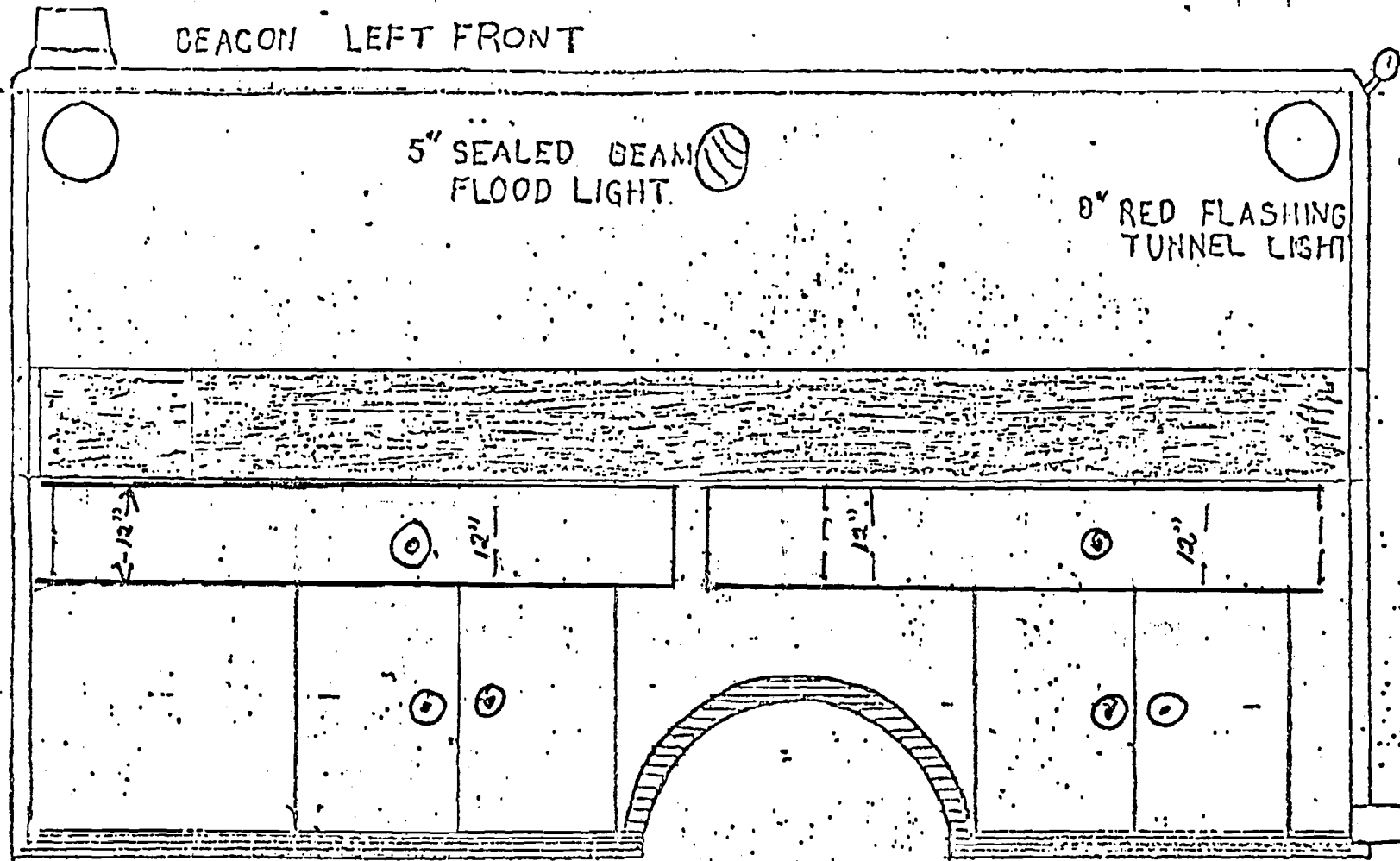

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
