

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 1st day of October, 1984, by and between the County of Nassau, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the Council on Aging, hereinafter referred to as the COUNCIL.

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of Nassau County that there be a Council on Aging, and

WHEREAS, the COUNCIL provide many services for the citizens of Nassau County;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1) For and in consideration of the sum of \$55,000.00, which shall be paid in quarterly installments, the COUNCIL does hereby agree to perform services that will benefit the residents of Nassau County. Said services to include but not limited to the following:

a) Continuing the present level of services provided for the aging at the COUNCIL'S main center.

2) The COUNCIL shall make their financial records available to the COUNTY for purposes of an audit, if requested, by the COUNTY.
