## **AGREEMENT**

- 1. Contractor agrees to make certain repairs to the Nassau County Courthouse for the amounts of money described in the attached Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein and made a part hereof by reference.
- 2. Owner agrees to pay Contractor for the work done and Contractor agrees to guarantee the work for one (1) year from the date of completion.
- 3. Contractor agrees to provide liability insurance to indemnify and hold harmless Owner from any liability whatsoever for any acts, whether direct or indirect of the repair activity being done by Contractor.
- 4. Contractor agrees that this work shall be completed within One Hundred and Fifty (150) days from the date of commencement and that he will begin said restoration on October 1, 1984.
- 5. Contractor agrees that this is a fixed price contract and all work described herein will be accomplished within the amounts of money set forth.
- 6. Contractor agrees to have a life insurance policy upon his life in the amount of this contract made payable to the County of Nassau until all work as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" has been completed.

7. This contract is not assignable by Contractor and it is understood that he will be responsible for all work described as well as any sub-contracted work which he wishes to have done in this project.
