

AGREEMENT

This agreement made this 15th day of April, 1986, between the Town of Hilliard, hereinafter referred to as the "Town", and Nassau County, hereinafter referred to as the "County".

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Town of Hilliard has a certain Ordinance #51 relating to the maintaining licensing, catching and destroying of dogs; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Hilliard has employed a Dog Catcher to enforce the provisions of said Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Hilliard does not have adequate facilities or equipment to catch, maintain and destroy all of the dogs caught in the Town; and

WHEREAS, Nassau County currently maintains an animal control facility near the Town of Hilliard; and,

WHEREAS, cost savings would result for both the Town and the County if the Town was to enforce its Ordinance and reimburse the County for the reasonable costs of maintaining, caring and destroying dogs caught by the Town.

1. Town shall be responsible during the term of this agreement for enforcing the provisions of the aforesaid Ordinance.

2. County agrees to maintain and care for any dogs caught and delivered to its facility during normal working hours by the Town. Town shall reimburse County the sum of \$2.00 per dog per day for each dog maintained.

3. Town shall reimburse the County the sum of \$2.00 for each dog destroyed in accordance with the Ordinance.

4. County shall from time to time loan the Town such equipment as it may need in order to enforce the provisions of the Ordinance if such is reasonably available and not in use.

5. This agreement shall be in effect until October 1, 1986.
