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#### THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

The Contract Documents consist of this Agreement, the Conditions of the Contract (General, Supplementa / and other Conditions), the Drawings, the Specifications, all Addenda issued prior to and all Modifications issued aft r execution of this Agreement. These form the Contract, and all are as fully a part of the Contract as if attached o this Agreement or repeated herein. An enumeration of the Contract Documents appears in Article 7.

#### **ARTICLE 2**

#### THE WORK

The Contractor shall perform all the Work required by the Contract Documents for (Here insert the caption descriptive of the Work as used on other Contract Documents.)

No painting of pipe or performing of electrical work is included in this project. W. W. Gay Fire Protection is not responsible for the replacement of any or all ceiling tiles.


#### ARTICLE 3

#### TIME OF COMMENCEMENT AND SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION

#### **ARTICLE 4**

#### **CONTRACT SUM**

The Owner shall pay the Contractor in current funds for the performance of the Work, subject to additions and deductions by Change Order as provided in the Contract Documents, the Contract Sum of Sixty-three thousand, seven hundred dollars & no/100 ----- \$63,700.00



#### ARTICLE 5

#### **PROGRESS PAYMENTS**

Not later than Thirty (30) days following the end of the period covered by the Application for Palment percent (100%) of the portion of the Contract Sum properly allocable to labor, material and equipment incorporated in the Work and percent (100%) of the portion of the Contract Sum properly allocable to materials and equipment suitably stored at the site or at some other location agreed upon in writing, for the period covered by the Application for Payment, less the aggregate of previous payments made by the Owner; and upon Substantial Completion of the entire Work, a sum sufficient to increase the total payments to percent (100%) of the Contract Sum, less such amounts as the Application for Palment or all incomplete Work and unsettled claims as provided in the Contract Documents.

#### **FINAL PAYMENT**


