## PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONSULTANT AGREEMENT

Item 1.

The CONSULTANT is changed from Marvin Hill and Associates, Architects and Planning Consultants, to Prosser, Hallock & Kristoff, Inc., Planners and Engineers (letter dated September 4, 1987).

Item 2.

<u>Port, Aviation and Related Facilities</u> will be rescheduled to Phase III of the work program.

Item 3.

Add in Phase II the following elements:

## Public Facilities

As a basis for establishing impact fees, an inventory of public facilities will be performed. This inventory will include those public facilities which are not included in the required survey of existing conditions under 9J-5. These will include fire and rescue service, public safety, and public administration space.

## Impact Fees

This task will include a revision of the existing Nassau County Impact Fee Ordinance (87-17) and fee schedule. Impact fees will be established for transportation, fire and rescue service, public safety, recreation, public administration space, and solid waste disposal.
