INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

THIS ACREEMENT is made and entered into this $28^{\frac{1}{10}}$ day ____, 19_{8} , by and between NASSAU COUNTY, a of _ political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose address is P. O. BOX 1010, FERNANDINA BEACH, Florida <u>32034</u>, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY; CITY OF CALLAHAN, a Florida municipal corporation, address is whose Florida _____, hereinafter referred to as CALLAHAN; CITY OF FERNANDINA BEACH, a Florida municipal corporation, whose address is P. O. BOX 668, FERNANDINA BEACH _-Florida 32034, hereinafter referred to as FERNANDINA BEACH;

CITY OF HILLIARD, a Florida municipal corporation, whose address is ______, Florida _____, hereinafter referred to as HILLIARD:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, CALLAHAN, FERNANDINA BEACH, HILLIARD, shall collectively hereinafter be referred to as CITIES; and

WHEREAS, the CITIES and COUNTY desire to mutually cooperate with each other; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, in a regular session on <u>July 28</u>, 1987, issued a Letter of Intent to allow Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company to proceed with preliminary implementation of a data based management emergency telephone system for Nassau County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, this emergency telephone system, commonly known as "E-911 SALI Emergency Number System," is intended to be implemented and maintained throughout Nassau County, including the incorporated as well as unincorporated area; and

WHEREAS, it is a necessity that certain information within the purview of the CITIES be transmitted to the COUNTY in order to institute, implement and maintain an effective Emergency Number System throughout Nassau County, Flőřida; and

WHEREAS, an "E-911 SALI Emergency Number System" would serve to promote, protect, and improve the health, safety, and welfare, of the citizens of Nassau County, Florida; and

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WHEREAS, a uniform system of street naming and numbering would facilitate the smooth operation of an "E-911 SALI Emergency Number System;" and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and CITIES have determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County, Florida, that this Interlocal Agreement be entered into.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and promises herein contained, it is mutually agreed between the parties as follows:

1. The CITIES hereby agree to submit to the Nassau County E-911 SALI Coordinator, Department of Emergency Services, Nassau County, Box 2, 11 North 14th Street, Fernandina Beach Florida 32034, the following information and documents approved by the CITIES, for the purpose of proper identification and location within the E-911 SALI Emergency Dispatch Data System:

(a) One copy of all enacted municipal ordinance(s) involving annexation of property or municipal contraction.

(b) One copy of any approved list regarding the renumbering on or renaming of any private or public streets or ways within each City's municipal boundaries, accompanied by information which assists in locating those streets on the City's official map.

(c) One copy of any approved list detailing numbering or naming of private or public streets or ways outside platted subdivisions within each City's municipal boundaries, accompanied by information which assists in locating those streets on the City's official map.

(d) One copy of each City's enacted Ordinances or Resolutions authorizing or regulating addressing accompanied by information which assists in locating affected areas on the City's official map.

(e) One copy of the official City maps whenever those maps are revised and reprinted.

(f) In those cases in which COUNTY administers the numbering of streets and ways within a municipality and the naming of private streets and ways outside platted subdivisions within a municipality, the municipality shall not be required to submit data regarding such numbering and naming mentioned in (b), (c) and (d) above.

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2. The CITIES hereby agree to avoid duplication of street names by consulting the E-911 SALI Coordinator's official data base of streets <u>prior to any permanent assignment</u> thereof. This document to be provided at least semi-annually by the E-911 SALI Coordinator to the CITIES.

3. The COUNTY shall provide the CITIES with a copy of each updated emergency zone street list applicable to each respective city as same becomes available, and any other information that is reasonably necessary to assist the CITIES in their efforts to implement and maintain the E-911 SALI system. The CITIES hereby agree to take under consideration any request made by COUNTY to cross municipal boundaries in order to cause a continuous flow of street numbering of public streets or ways.

4. The CITIES and COUNTY hereby agree to mutually cooperate in maintaining the smooth and full flow of communication and all current and complete information necessary to efficiently properly and effectively institute, implement and maintain the E-911 SALI Emergency Number System throughout the entirety of Nassau County, Florida.

5. The CITIES agree to adhere and conform to the COUNTY's uniform building numbering ordinance by either adopting a substantially identical ordinance or resolution or otherwise conforming to the substance of the COUNTY ordinance, a copy of which is attached hereto and which is incorporated herein by its reference; provided, however, that any and all amendments to the said Ordinance shall be equally binding if approved by a city. It is the intent of all parties hereto to maintain a uniform system of building numbering within Nassau County.

Dear Mr. Hodges;

Chief Graves has asked me to send you a letter explaining the Interlocal Agreement that Nassau County and Callahan are considering to facilitate the implementation of the new enhanced 911 system within Nassau County. The Interlocal Agreement is simply a statement that the County's and the City of Callahan's intent to work together in order to provide the best possible emergency services to the citizens of the county. The agreement states that the City will work with the county to eliminate duplication of street names and addresses within the county. The City will also help the County in the mapping process by supplying information that is readily available in the form of maps or other documents that will help in assigning individual addresses throughout the City and County.

The City will not be required to expend any funds by this agreement. The work that is to be done to create the maps and addressing system for 911 will be funded through the existing 911 toll that is being collected now. This toll provides for the funding to purchase the equipment to operate the enhanced 911 system and to perform the work necessary to implement the system.

At this time the County is establishing Interlocal Agreements with the Town of Hilliard and Fernandina Beach as well as the City of Callahan. Chief Graves has informed me that the City of Fernandina Beach has already approved this agreement.
