RE: Cost to implement Nassau County's Gas Monitoring Investigation for the Lofton Creek and Bryceville Landfills, as required by the Florida Department of Environmental Regulation (FDER)

Dear Mr. Lecher:

GWL, Inc. is pleased to submit a cost breakdown for the implementation of the Gas Migration Investigation at the Lofton Creek and Bryceville Landfills. FDER indicates that six to eight temporary gas migration wells should be installed and sampled at each site to detect the volume of gas (if any) that is generated from the landfills. This study will fulfill FDER's requirements for a gas migration investigation.

The following is the scope and costs to implement the Gas Monitoring Investigation for both sites:
