TIME OF PERFORMANCE

The design and preparation of construction documents are to be completed within 60 days.

FEES TO BE PAID

For items stated in the Scope of services, the ENGINEER shall be paid the following amounts:

Design Phase Services \$18,900 Construction Phase Services 1,800

Total \$20,700

INSURANCE

The ENGINEER and the OWNER shall each effect and maintain insurance to protect themselves from claims under worker's compensation acts; claims for damages because of bodily injury including personal injury, sickness or disease, or death of any of their employees or of any person other than their employees; and from claims for damages because of injury to or destruction to tangible property including loss of use resulting therefrom.

The OWNER shall be liable and agrees to be liable for, and shall indemnify, defend and hold the ENGINEER harmless for any and all claims, suits, judgments or damages, losses and expenses including court costs, expert witness and professional consultation services, and attorneys' fees arising out of the services performed by the OWNER, the OWNER'S errors, omissions, and/or negligence, or those of any and all sub-consultants. The OWNER shall not be liable to nor indemnify the ENGINEER for any portions of damages arising out of any error, omission, and/or negligence of the ENGINEER.

TERMINATION

This Agreement may be terminated by either party by giving thirty (30) days advance written notice. The ENGINEER shall be paid for services rendered to the date of termination on the basis of a reasonable estimate of the portion of services completed prior to termination and shall be paid for all reasonable expenses

resulting from such termination and for any unpaid reimbursable expenses.

ACCEPTANCE

Acceptance of this proposal may be indicated by the signature of a duly authorized official of the OWNER in the space provided below. One signed copy of this Agreement returned to the ENGINEER will serve as an Agreement between the two parties. This Agreement will be binding on the parties hereto and the parties' successors and assigns. Should this proposal not be accepted within a period of sixty (60) days from the above date, it shall become null and void.
