## FORM OF AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made this  $15^{\text{H}}$  day of <u>Oclobus</u>, 19 <u>9</u>, A.D., by and between Nassau County Board of Commissioners, hereinafter called "OWNER" and Appliance Recycling Centers of America, Inc., doing business as a corporation hereinafter called "CONTRACTOR".

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the payments and agreements hereinafter mentioned:

- 1. The CONTRACTOR will commence the pickup and processing of white goods from the West Nassau Landfill.
- 2. The CONTRACTOR will furnish all the materials, supplies, tools, equipment, labor and other services necessary for the performance of the WORK described herein.
- 3. The CONTRACTOR will commence the work required by the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS upon receipt of the NOTICE TO PROCEED and will continue to pick-up and process white goods from the West Nassau Landfill as called for in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS until contract expiration on September 30, 1991.
- 4. The CONTRACTOR agrees to perform all of the Work described in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS and comply with the terms therein for the sum of \$8.66 per unit as shown in the Proposal Schedule.
- 5. The term "CONTRACT DOCUMENTS" means and includes the following:
  - (A) Request for Quotes
  - (B) Specifications prepared by Nassau County
  - (C) Proposal
  - (D) Notice to Proceed
  - (E) Form of Agreement
- 6. The CONTRACTOR shall invoice the OWNER. Such invoice shall be itemized as to amounts and types of white goods picked-up and processed.
- 7. The OWNER shall pay to the CONTRACTOR amounts invoiced, upon verification and approval, in a timely manner.
- 8. This agreement shall be binding upon all parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed or caused to be executed by their duly authorized officials, this Agreement in triplicate each of which shall be deemed an original on the date first above written.
