#### AGREEMENT

This agreement is made by and between <u>Brd. of Co. Comm. Nassau Co.</u>, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (the County), and the FLORIDA HIGHWAY PATROL, a division of the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (FHP), pursuant to Section 163.01, Florida Statutes, authorizing interlocal agreements.

In consideration of mutual promises contained in this interlocal agreement, the County and FHP accept the following terms and conditions:

#### 1. Radar

For the purpose of this agreement, radar shall mean law enforcement speed radar, any microwave-based speed-measurement unit that meets the minimum design criteria established by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (HSMV) and is employed for use in the State of Florida by a law enforcement agency to detect the speed of motorists. As contemplated by this agreement, radar units shall include any hardware necessary for the operation and maintenance of such equipment, including tuning forks. The radar equipment governed by this agreement was purchased by the County for operation by the FHP within Nassau County

#### 2. Maintenance of Radar Equipment

Nassau Board of County Commissioners shall be the lawful owner of the radar. Nassau Board of County Commissioners shall be responsible for maintenance, repair and re-certification of the radars for the first three years of this agreement. Florida Highway Patrol shall be the custodian during these three years. After the above three years Florida Highway Patrol shall be the custodian and shall be responsible for the maintenance, repair and re-certification of such radar equipment. FHP shall be

responsible for the installation and operation of such equipment as required by the laws of Florida and the rules, policies, and procedures of HSMV.

3. Operation of Radar

Approved as to form

FHP shall operate auch radar in a lawful manner to detect the appead of motoriats, to reduce the incidents of excessive speed, and to promote the health, safety, and welfare of persons who travel the highways and roadways of Massau County. If FHP officers operating such radar are reassigned to any other County, the radar equipment shall remain in Massau County. FHP, however, may operate the radar in any County of this state upon limited temporary assignment or special detail, pursuant to the laws of Florida and the rules, policies, and procedure of HSMV.
