

AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners approved Ordinance 93-14, as amended, which established the MSBU for beach renourishment, and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance provided for services to be accomplished by the Tax Collector of Nassau County, and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector is entitled to a fee for the services of her office.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of ten and no/100 dollars (\$10.00), the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "Board", and Gwendolyn M. Miller, Tax Collector of Nassau County, Florida, agree as follows:


1. The Tax Collector shall receive \$12,000 as and for a fee arrangement. Said amount shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the first collections of the assessment.

2. The Tax Collector is entitled to two percent (2%) of the total collections. Said amount is to be deducted from each check transaction by the Tax Collector.


3. The Tax Collector shall also record all liens and lien satisfactions. The Tax Collector shall be entitled to two percent (2%) of all monies paid pursuant to these liens.

4. The Board agrees to hold the Tax Collector harmless for any and all duties performed pursuant to this Agreement.


