1. The attached agreement entitled "An interlocal agreement between Nassau County, Florida, and the Town of Callahan for the purpose of coordinating the expenditure of State Housing Initiative Partnership (Ship) funding between The County and the Town" is hereby approved and accepted

by the Town Council of the Town of Callahan, Florida.

- 2. The Town of Callahan, Florida, hereby adopts the "SHIP Affordable Housing Incentive Plan" previously adopted by Nassau County, Florida, as it may be revised from time to time.
- 3. The Mayor and the Town Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the Town and deliver the executed agreement to Nassau County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, acting by and through its Board of County Commissioners.
