

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Nassau County, pursuant to Florida Statutes, 212.055(3), qualifies for the small county surtax; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County to utilize the proceeds of a 0.5 cent sales tax for operating expenses for the Nassau County landfill; and

WHEREAS, the utilization of the sales tax will allow the reduction of the assessment and the commercial tipping fee; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Callahan is entitled, under the statutory formula, to receive ±\$39,407.00 of the monies collected; and

WHEREAS, the amount the County would receive is ±\$1,500,000.00, and that would reduce the tipping fee to \$57.00 per ton and the annual assessment to \$72.00; and

WHEREAS, if each City contributes their share towards the operational expenses of the West Nassau Landfill, the tipping fee would be further reduced to \$45.00 per ton, and the annual assessment would be further reduced to \$59.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Callahan and the Board of County Commissioners agree that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Nassau County to utilize all the monies generated from the 0.5 cent sales tax to reduce the tipping fee and the annual assessment of the citizens of Nassau County, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR and IN CONSIDERATION of the mutually agreed upon consideration the parties agree as follows:

1. The Town of Callahan's statutory share of the 0.5 cent


sales tax shall be given to the Board of County Commissioners to be used for the operational expenses of the West Nassau Landfill.


2. If each City contributes their statutory share, the Board of County Commissioners agrees to reduce the tipping fee to \$45.00 per ton and the annual assessment to \$59.00.

3. This Agreement shall remain in effect as long as the sales surtax is collected by the County.






