

CONTRACT FOR RECYCLING AND EDUCATION PROGRAM MANAGEMENT

This contract entered into on this date December 12, 1994, by and between Nassau County Board of County Commissioners (County) and Keep Nassau Beautiful, Inc. (KNB).

The parties agree as follows:


1. KNB will monitor all County multi-material drop-off sites for use, aesthetics and contamination. Monthly written reports will be submitted to the Solid Waste Management Department outlining conditions and recommending improvements.
2. KNB will review multi-material site locations to determine the effectiveness of the site and recommend the need for additional sites and overall improvements in the County's recycling program.
3. KNB will provide promotion of the County's total recycling program through education and information, development of a County motto, mascot and theme, development of a County-wide school program and development of educational and informational materials.
4. KNB will collect and tabulate data to determine County-wide recycling rates, quantities and qualities of materials and total program effectiveness.
5. KNB will keep abreast of new and innovative recycling technology and keep the County informed.
6. KNB will research, develop and recommend markets for recycling commodities to determine commodities to be collected, processed and marketed. KNB will develop a local "recycled content" procurement strategy for the County.
7. KNB will submit a bill to the County quarterly for the above mentioned services at a rate of \$7,917.00 per quarter.

8. County will provide support to the Recycling and Education Program with ordinance development, code enforcement and site monitoring where it would be convenient and not interfere with other county activities.


9. Educational and informational materials will be provided by the County within budgetary constraints.




