Oversight Assistance

Commissioner Higginbotham:

Roy F. Weston, Inc. (WESTON) is pleased to provide this proposal for continued service to Nassau County, Florida, for Third Party Engineering Services and Owner's Representation relative to construction at the West Nassau Landfill site and related solid waste management system support as referenced herein. Our proposal reflects our projected costs through September 30, 1995.

The nature of our services are fully defined in Attachments A, B, C, and D. Our subsequent estimate to provide these services is broken down by activities that we expect to be encountered through September 30, 1995.

Construction at the West Nassau Landfill has been completed through Cells 1, 2, and 3 (active). The construction activities on side slopes directly above these cells is finished and we expect Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) site inspection and approval shortly. Construction activities are ongoing in Cells 4 and 5, as well as in the North Addition. We do not anticipate any new construction quality assurance activities to start before March 1, 1995, which is reflected in Attachment B.

The County is in the process of submitting a major modification to its Construction and Operating Permit at the West Nassau Landfill to combine two permits (current closure permit for the old landfill and the new permit for vertical expansion). This will eliminate ten groundwater monitoring wells and upgrade the groundwater monitoring plan to meet the new 1994 regulations adopted in April. WESTON is providing technical review and assistance in preparing this modification. In addition, WESTON will be preparing the submittals to FDEP for the County to finalize the acceptance of the waste from Clay County, Florida, and the changes in the Company that is hauling and disposing of the leachate.

WESTON will provide assistance in other solid waste management areas as needed and requested. We have identified these areas as we understand them to be at this time in Attachment C.

WESTON's services described herein will continue to be billed based on hourly charges for type of service provided plus direct expenses. It has been a pleasure to work with the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners and Solid Waste Department over the past three years to provide an environmentally sound and economically acceptable method of solid waste management.






