AGREEMENT BETWEEN CONTRACTOR AND OWNER

THE PROJECT: **SIGNALIZATION OF SIMMONS ROAD AND 14TH STREET** Nassau County, Florida

The Contractor and Owner agree as set forth below:

The Contractor shall perform all the work required and supply all of the necessary materials to provide ongoing traffic signal maintenance and repair services, including: preventative maintenance services, inventory services, and signal timing services as approved by Nassau County.

For work performed under this Agreement, the Contractor shall take direction from the Nassau County Public Works Director or his designated representative.

The Contractor will provide Owner with proof of insurance coverage prior to starting work.


The Owner shall pay the Contractor in current funds for the performance of the work in accordance with the basic fee schedule. The Owner shall make payments under this contract within 45 days of the receipt of an invoice.

The Contractor shall be deemed to be an independent contractor in all its operations and activities here under. The employees furnished by the Contractor to perform the work shall be deemed to be the Contractor's employees and said employees shall be paid by the Contractor for all services in this connection. The Contractor shall be responsible for all obligations and reports covering Social Security, Unemployment Insurance, Workman's Compensation, Income Tax, and other reports and deductions required by an applicable State or Federal law.

Services performed by the Contractor under this Agreement will be conducted in a manner consistent with that level of care and skill ordinarily exercised by members of the Contractor's profession currently practicing in the same locality under similar conditions.



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
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
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
