HRS Nassau County Public Health Unit has been awarded fund increases for Contract Year 1994-1995, as follows: Women, Infant & Children Supplemental Food Program (WIC) \$22,556; Tobacco Prevention & Control \$3,900; Hepatitis B Stipend \$1,315; Immunization Outreach Team \$12,962; Radiological Health (RADON Surcharge) \$47; for a total increase of \$40,780.

As specified in Attachment I, Special Provisions, paragraph I.F. of the HRS County Public Health Unit Contract, either party may add funds to the contract upon written notification to the other party. If a written objection to the increase is not filed within 30 days of date of this letter, the increase will be approved.

IX. Payment for Services:

A. The department agrees:

To pay for services identified in Schedule "C" of the operating budget (General Revenue and Federal), and reflected in Attachment II, Part II, as the State's appropriated responsibility in an amount not to exceed $\frac{1,232,774}{}$; and the State share of all state authorized fees in an anticipated amount of $\frac{104314}{}$. In addition, all "OTHER" state revenues from whatever sources to be appropriated to the HRS County Public Health Unit Trust Fund for services to be provided by the county health unit in an amount of $\frac{66,706}{}$, for a grand total State cash contribution of $\frac{1,403,794}{}$. The State's obligation to pay under this contract is contingent upon an annual appropriation by the legislature.

B. The county agrees:

To pay for services identified in Attachment II, Part II, as the county's responsibility in an appropriated amount not to exceed $\frac{369,752}{}$. In addition, the county shall provide its share of all county authorized fees in an anticipated amount of $\frac{60,351}{}$. These amounts, plus any "OTHER" local revenues in the amount of $\frac{87,244}{}$, includes all revenues from whatever sources to be appropriated to the HRS County Public Health Unit Trust Fund for services to be provided by the county health unit for a grand total county cash contribution of $\frac{518,547}{}$

X. The department and the county mutually agree:

A. Effective date:

- 1. This contract shall begin on October 1, 19 94 or the date on which the contract has been signed by both parties, whichever is later.
- 2. This contract shall end on September 30, 1995.

B. Termination:

1. Termination because of lack of funds:

In the event funds to finance this contract become unavailable, either party may terminate the contract upon no less then twenty-four hours notice in writing to the other party. Said notice shall be delivered by certified mail, return receipt requested, or in person with proof of
