In other words, all references in Attachment A to <u>First Contract Period</u> deliverable due dates are hereby amended to reflect that the term of the First Contract Period commences on the date of execution and terminates October 31, 1998.

WHEREAS, based upon the delay in the Department's provision of The Arbiter of Storms (TAOS) computer modeling data to the Contractor, the parties desire to modify said Agreement to revise the third and fourth period deliverable due dates.

NOW, THEREFORE, the above-referenced agreement is modified as follows:

In Attachment A, all references to <u>Third Contract Period</u> deliverable due dates are hereby amended to reflect that the terms of the Third Contract Period commence on the date of execution and terminate August 31, 1999.

In Attachment A, Item III.A., all references to data to be provided by the Department to the County shall be amended to include a delivery date of April 30, 1999.

In Attachment A, all references to <u>Fourth Contract Period</u> are amended to reflect that the terms of the Fourth Contract Period commence on the date of execution and terminate October 29, 1999.

All other provisions of the Agreement not inconsistent with this Modification #2 remain in full force and effect.
