AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this $_13th$ day of $_December$, 1999, by and between the County of Nassau, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the Episcopal Child Care and Development Centers, Inc., hereinafter referred to as CHILD CARE CENTER.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that the EPISCOPAL CHILD CARE CONNECTION, program continue, and

WHEREAS, the CHILD CARE CENTER provides quality day care to Nassau County's low income children and parents;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. For and in consideration of the sum of \$12,058.00, which shall be paid in quarterly installments, during the months of November, February, May and August, the CHILD CARE CENTER does hereby agree to perform services that will benefit the residents of Nassau County. Said services to include but not be limited to the following:
 - a. Continuing the present level of services provided for the economically deprived children and parents of Nassau County, Florida.
 - 2. The CHILD CARE CENTER shall make their financial records available to the COUNTY for purposes of an audit, if requested by the COUNTY. The COUNTY shall require an audit of previous year's financial records to be performed by an independent accounting firm. The audit report must be presented to the COUNTY before the May distribution will be made.
- 3. All facilities, programs and services should be compliant with the Florida Accessibility Guide and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
