
Dear Chairman Cooper:

Background:

Staff has requested an extension from the FDOT of the reimbursement agreement for the construction of the Sadler Road Roundabout due to the county's delays in obtaining the required permit from St. Johns River Water Management District. The FDOT has agreed to extend the agreement until March 15, 2001 and has provided an extension document for the Board to execute. Mr. Mullin has prepared a new resolution to amend Resolution 99-17 approving the execution of the original agreement with FDOT.
