

Any deed whereby the FCT Recipient acquires title to the Project Site shall contain such covenants and restrictions as are sufficient to ensure that the use of the Project Site at all times complies with Section 375.051, Florida Statutes and Section 9, Article XII of the State Constitution and shall contain clauses providing for the conveyance of title to the Project Site in the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund upon failure to use the Project Site conveyed thereby for such purposes.
- 4. A Grant Award Agreement containing such covenants and restrictions as are sufficient to ensure that the use of the Project Site at all times complies with Section 375.051, Florida Statutes and Section 9, Article XII of the State Constitution, containing clauses providing for the conveyance of title to the Project Site in the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund upon failure to use the Project Site for such purposes and describing the real property subject to the Agreement shall be executed by the FCT and FCT Recipient at the time of the conveyance of the Project Site and shall be recorded in the county in which the Project Site is located.

#### ADDENDUM XIV TO CONCEPTUAL APPROVAL AGREEMENT

THIS ADDENDUM XIV to the Conceptual Approval Agreement is entered into by and between the FLORIDA COMMUNITIES TRUST ("FCT"), a nonregulatory agency within the State of Florida Department of Community Affairs, and NASSAU COUNTY ("FCT Recipient"), this 2000.

WHEREAS, the parties hereto entered into a Conceptual Approval Agreement which sets forth the conditions of conceptual approval that must be satisfied by FCT Recipient prior to the receipt of the FCT Preservation 2000 Series 1992A award and the restrictions that are imposed on the Project Site subsequent to its acquisition with the FCT Preservation 2000 Series 1992A award;

WHEREAS, the initial term of the Conceptual Approval Agreement expired April 8, 1994;

WHEREAS, the Conceptual Approval Agreement was extended by ADDENDUM I to October 7, 1994, by ADDENDUM II to April 7, 1995, by ADDENDUM III to October 7, 1995, by ADDENDUM IV to expire April 7, 1996, by ADDENDUM VI to expire April 7, 1997, by ADDENDUM VII to expire October 7, 1997, by ADDENDUM VIII to expire April 7, 1998, by ADDENDUM IX to expire October 7, 1998, by ADDENDUM X to expire April 7, 1999, by ADDENDUM XI to expire October 7, 1999, by ADDENDUM XII, to decrease the grant award amount and expire April 7, 2000, and by ADDENDUM XIII to expire October 7, 2000;

WHEREAS, the FCT Recipient in accordance with GENERAL CONDITIONS paragraph 2 of the Conceptual Approval Agreement and in compliance with Rule 9K-4.010(2)(h), F.A.C. (1992), has timely submitted to FCT a written request for extension of the October 7, 2000 deadline;

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to extend the term of the Conceptual Approval Agreement as provided by Rule 9K-4.010(2)(k), F.A.C. (1992); and

WHEREAS, Section 216.3491, Florida Statutes, the Florida Single Audit Act, provides uniform state audit requirements for state financial assistance provided by state agencies over the audit threshold as defined in that Section;

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to make these requirements a part of the Conceptual Approval Agreement as provided by Rule 9K-4.010(2)(j), F.A.C.;

WHEREAS, GENERAL CONDITIONS paragraph 10 of the Conceptual Approval Agreement states that the agreement may be amended at any time prior to FCT giving final project plan approval to the FCT Recipient. Any agreement must be set forth in a written instrument and agreed to by both the FCT Recipient and FCT;

NOW THEREFORE, the FCT and FCT RECIPIENT mutually agree as follows:

- 1. Notwithstanding the language of Section I. GENERAL CONDITIONS, paragraph 2. and paragraph 10., the parties hereby agree to revive it nunc pro tunc as though it had not lapsed in accordance with paragraph 2.
- 2. In every respect, this amendment is to be construed and applied as though the parties had both signed it before October 7, 2000.
- 3. The Conceptual Approval Agreement by and between FCT and FCT Recipient is hereby extended until April 7, 2001.
- 4. The Conceptual Approval Agreement by and between FCT and Recipient is hereby amended to add Section IX as follows:

#### IX. AUDIT REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The Recipient agrees to maintain financial procedures and support documents, in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, to account for the receipt and expenditure of funds under this Agreement.
- 2. These records shall be available at all reasonable times for inspection, review, or audit by state personnel and other personnel duly authorized by FCT. "Reasonable" shall be construed according to circumstances, but ordinarily shall mean normal business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., local time, Monday through Friday.
- 3. The Recipient shall also provide FCT with the records, reports or financial statements upon request for the purposes of auditing and monitoring the funds awarded under this Agreement.
- 4. In the event that the Recipient expends a total amount of State financial assistance <u>from all state sources</u> equal to or in excess of \$300,000 in any fiscal year of such Recipient, the Recipient must have a State single or project-specific audit for such fiscal year in accordance with Section 216.3491, Florida Statutes; applicable rules of the Executive Office of the Governor and the Comptroller, and Chapter 10.600, Rules of the Auditor General.
  - Section I.7. above indicates State financial assistance through FCT by this Agreement. In determining the State financial assistance expended in its fiscal year, the Recipient shall consider all sources of State financial assistance, including State funds received from FCT, except that State financial assistance received by a nonstate entity for Federal program matching requirements shall be excluded from consideration. The funding for this Agreement was received by FCT as a grant appropriation.
  - a. The annual financial audit report shall include all management letters and the Recipient's response to all findings, including corrective actions to be taken.
  - b. The annual financial audit report shall include a schedule of financial assistance specifically identifying all Agreement and other revenue by sponsoring agency and Agreement number.

c. The complete financial audit report, including all items specified in 4 above, shall be sent directly to:

Department of Community Affairs Office of Audit Services 2555 Shumard Oak Boulevard Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2100

and

State of Florida Auditor General Attn: Ted J Sauerbeck Room 574, Claude Pepper Building 111 West Madison Street Tallahassee. Florida 32302-1450

- d. In connection with the audit requirements addressed above, the Recipient shall ensure that the audit complies with the requirements of Section 216.3491(7), Florida Statutes. This includes submission of a reporting package as defined by Section 216.3491(2)(d), Florida Statutes, and Chapter 10.600, Rules of the Auditor General.
- e. If the Recipient expends less than \$300,000 in State financial assistance in its fiscal year, an audit conducted in accordance with the provisions of Section 216.3491, Florida Statutes, is not required. In the event that the Recipient expends less than \$300,000 in State financial assistance in its fiscal year and elects to have an audit conducted in accordance with the provisions of Section 216.3491, Florida Statutes, the cost of the audit must be paid from non-State funds (i.e., the cost of such an audit must be paid from recipient funds obtained from other than State entities).
- 5. In the event the audit shows that the entire funds disbursed hereunder, or any portion thereof, were not spent in accordance with the conditions of this Agreement, the Recipient shall be held liable for reimbursement to FCT of all funds not spent in accordance with these applicable regulations and Agreement provisions within thirty (30) days after FCT has notified the Recipient of such non-compliance.
- 6. The Recipient shall retain all financial records, supporting documents, statistical records, and any other documents pertinent to this contract for a period of three years after the date of submission of the final expenditures report. However, if litigation or an audit has been initiated prior to the expiration of the three-year period, the records shall be retained until the litigation or audit findings have been resolved.
- 7. The Recipient shall have all audits completed in accordance with 216.3491, Florida Statutes, by an independent auditor who shall either be a certified public accountant or an external state or local governmental auditor. The independent auditor shall state that the audit complied with the applicable provisions noted above.

5. The date of execution of this addendum shall be the date that the last party signs this addendum
