Please forward this scope to your County continuing contract consultants for professional services for the above referenced project located in the Town of Hilliard, Nassau County, Florida. A site location map (copy of aerial photo) is attached for your convenience, which depicts locations of proposed borings.

Below is a list of anticipated surveying services needed:

- Provide the location of all well and septic tank/drainfield systems within 100 feet of the property. Locate the existing drainage ditches and swales around the site, including the outfall direction 100' from the site.
- Provide boundary survey. All casements, right-of-ways and encroachments should be shown.
- Provide a tree survey, which meets requirements and description of the regulatory agency, on a signed and sealed letter stating there exists no trees.
- 4. Provide wetland survey as flagged by the Biologist (if applicable). Provided follow-up survey if adjustments to flagging are made by the Jurisdictional Agency. Provide locations and elevations of biological indicators and markers set by the Biologist.
