Great Florida Birding Trail Sign Maintenance Agreement

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, 620 South Meridian St., Tallahassee, FL 32399-1600 (FWC) and Marianne Marshall, Chairman, Board of County Commissioners, as an authorized agent for and on behalf of Nassau County, P.O. Box 1010, Fernandina Beach, FL 32035 do hereby agree that the County shall maintain the Great Florida Birding Trail Sign (signs), installed along Lake Hampton Road within Nassau County, Florida. The County shall perform maintenance consisting of the following:

Periodic inspection of all signs, including:

- ⌘ Ensuring clear visibility from the roadway. Any obstructions shall be removed or the sign(s) relocated to provide adequate visibility.
- ⌘ Inspection of sign posts, foundations, brackets, etc., for any defects. Any such defects shall be repaired/replaced in accordance with Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) standards.

⊗ Replacement of damaged or missing signs. The County shall contact the FWC to request replacement signage as necessary. Requests should be addressed to the following:






