

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 1st day of October, 2001, by and between the County of Nassau, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the NORTHEAST FLORIDA FAIR ASSOCIATION, hereinafter referred to as FAIR ASSOCIATION.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County, Florida to have a Northeast Florida Fair Association for the betterment and enjoyment by all the citizens of Nassau County, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. For and in consideration of the sum of \$5,040.00, the FAIR ASSOCIATION does hereby agree to perform services that will benefit the residents of Nassau County. Said services to include but not be limited to:

- a. Promotion of agriculture and extension services in conjunction with the county
- b. Improvement of capital projects on the fair grounds located in Callahan, Florida.
- c. Sponsor the annual Northeast Florida Fair.

The Fair Association further agrees to:

- a. Provide the required number of accessible parking facilities for mobility impaired individuals.
2. The FAIR ASSOCIATION shall make their financial records available to the COUNTY for purposes of an audit, if requested by the COUNTY.
3. All facilities, programs and services shall be compliant with the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Failure to provide facilities, programs and services that are compliant with the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) shall be considered a breach of the contract.


