Thank you for the opportunity to offer additional post design services on the above referenced project. Based on our previous contract dated 4/22/02 and payments made by the County totaling \$14,496.12 | have reviewed our files and note the following. Three invoices which exceeded our original contract amount were sent and remain unpaid. The invoices are: #02-374 dated 10/29/02 \$966.25, #02-325 dated 10/16/02 \$873.28 and #02-301 dated 9/30/02 \$1,143.16. Since 10/29/02 we have incurred additional unbilled job costs totaling \$6,508.05. Based upon meetings, discussions, status of the project, and anticipated remaining work, I offer the following scope of engineering work and corresponding fees.

- 1. Attend County meetings during construction phase to address public concerns.
- 2. Prepare design calculations and revised plans to incorporate a piped system from Scott Road all the way to the A-1-A crossing. Submit to SJRWMD and DOT for permit modifications.
- 3. Perform continued minimal inspections as necessary during construction.
- 4. Respond to Requests for Information from the Contractor or Owner.
- 5. At the Owner's request, review shop drawings, diagrams, illustrations, brochures, catalog data, schedules and samples, the results of tests and inspections, any other data which the Contractor is required to submit for the purpose of verifying acceptability in conformance with the requirements and information given in the Contract Documents, and review maintenance and operating instructions, schedules, guarantees, bonds and certificates of inspection as required in construction contracts related to the project.
