

Background: The Board of County Commissioners on May 14, 2003 approved a contract with APAC-Florida, Inc. – Jacksonville Division to complete the intersection improvements for Church Road and US 1 in the amount of \$76,683.68. The project has been completed, however, the contract has not been closed out. In order to close out the contract, several adjustments need to be made to the quantities originally submitted to reflect the actual quantities measured in place in the field.

In addition, two other contract modifications need to be made. The project was permitted through FDOT as the majority of the work took place in their ROW. The permit required the use of silt fencing and hay bales. These two items were not included in the contractors' original proposal as they were not shown on the plans bid on by the contractor. The contractor in has submitted a proposal of \$770.55 for these items. The second item is to establish a pay item for Concrete Driveway required by the FDOT permit. The contractor has submitted a proposal in the amount of \$3,152.80 for the installation of the concrete driveway and associated MES's.

A change order reflecting the adjusted quantities has been attached for your review.

Financial/Economic Impact to Future Years Budgeting Process or Effect on Citizens: Would have a minimal impact on future roadway improvement projects to be funded by 505 Transportation Impact Fees.

Action requested and recommendation: Staff requests and recommends that the Board of County Commissioners approve Change Order No. 001 to APAC-Florida, Inc. in the amount of \$3,439.71 in order to close out the US 1 / Church Road Turn Lane project.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND RELEASE

THIS SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND RELEASE is made and entered into on the last date of execution below, between and among APAC-SOUTHEAST, INC., (hereinafter "APAC"), NASSAU COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, (hereinafter "COUNTY"), and WINDSTREAM FLORIDA, INC. f/k/a ALLTEL FLORIDA, INC., (hereinafter "WINDSTREAM").

BACKGROUND

- A. In August 1998, APAC and the County entered into a contract for construction of County Road 108 from County Road 121 to U.S. 1 in Callahan, Florida (hereinafter the "Project"). In August 2003, APAC sued the COUNTY for breach of contract and claimed damages. In December 2003, County filed a Third Party Complaint against WINDSTREAM requesting indemnification and other relief associated with the Project. The above-referenced claims are pending in the action entitled APAC-Southeast, Inc. v. Nassau County v. Windstream Florida, Inc. f/n/a Alltel-Florida, Inc., Case No. 03-478-CA, pending in the Fourth Judicial Circuit in and for Nassau County Florida.
- B. To fully and finally resolve this matter, the Parties have agreed to the terms set forth herein.

AGREEMENT

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and other good and valuable consideration, the Parties agree as follows:

1. RELEASE AND DISCHARGE

In consideration of the payment set forth below and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the Parties their assigns, administrators, trustees, agents, legal representatives, and successors, completely release, acquit, and discharge, and by these presents do hereby release, acquit, waive and forever discharge one another, their past, present, and future employees, officers, directors, attorneys, agents, insurers, consultants, sureties, subcontractors, servants, representatives, trustees, successors in interest, assigns, parents, subsidiaries, and affiliates of and from all past, present, or future claims, demands, suits, debts, controversies, issues, disputes, agreements, promises, variances, trespasses, judgments, executions, liabilities, obligations, actions, causes of action, breach of contract claims, pass-through claims of subcontractors, damages, costs, attorney's fees and litigation costs, expenses, and compensation of any kind or nature whatsoever, whether based on tort, contract, or any other theory of recovery, which any of them has, or which may hereafter accrue or otherwise be acquired, on account of, or in any way arising from the subject Project, whether or not asserted in this lawsuit. This Release and Discharge shall be fully binding and a complete settlement, release and discharge of any and all liability between and among the Parties.

2. RELEASE OF ALL DAMAGES

The Parties each hereby further acknowledge and agree that the Release and Discharge set forth in Paragraph 1 expressly waives and assumes the risk of any and all claims for damages which exist as of this date, including those of which the Parties do not know or suspect to exist, whether through ignorance, oversight, error, negligence, or otherwise, and which, if known, would materially affect the decision the Parties to enter into this Settlement Agreement and Release. The Parties further agree that they have accepted or paid the sums specified herein as a complete compromise and settlement of matters involving disputed issues of law and fact and they assume the risk that the facts or law may be otherwise than they believe. It is understood and agreed by the Parties that this settlement is a compromise of doubtful and disputed claims, and the payment is not to be construed as an admission of liability on the part of the Parties, by whom liability is expressly denied.

3. <u>PAYMENT</u>

In consideration of the Release and Discharge set forth above, the County agrees to pay to APAC the sum of TWENTY THOUSAND dollars (\$20,000.00). In further consideration of the Release and Discharge set forth above, Windstream agrees to pay to APAC the sum of TWENTY THOUSAND dollars (\$20,000.00). These sums shall be paid within thirty (30) days from the full execution of this Settlement Agreement and Release by the last party to execute this Settlement Agreement and Release, after which time interest shall accrue at the approved statutory rate.

4. ATTORNEY'S FEES AND COSTS

The Parties hereto shall pay their own attorney's fees, costs and expenses of any nature incurred in connection with the claims submitted by APAC to the County and those claims submitted by the County to Windstream, including this lawsuit, any mediation and negotiation of this settlement, the drafting of this Settlement Agreement and Release, and the matters and documents referred to herein, and all other matters related to this settlement.

5. WARRANTY OF CAPACITY TO EXECUTE THIS SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Parties each represent and warrant to the other that no other person, firm or corporation has or has had any interest in the claims, demands, obligations, or causes of action referred to in this Settlement Agreement and Release, except as otherwise set forth herein, and that they have the sole right and exclusive authority to execute this Settlement Agreement and Release and to pay and receive the sum specified in it; and that none of the Parties have sold, assigned, transferred, conveyed, compromised or otherwise disposed of any of the claims, demands, obligations, or causes of action referred to in this Settlement Agreement and Release.

6. <u>ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND SUCCESSORS IN INTEREST</u>

This Settlement Agreement and Release contains the entire agreement between the Parties with regard to the matters set forth herein, and all prior oral or written representations merge and are integrated herein, and shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the personal representatives, successors and assigns of each.

7. REPRESENTATIONS OF COMPREHENSION OF SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

In entering this Settlement Agreement and Release, the Parties represent that each has read the agreement and understands the content and effect of this Settlement Agreement and Release. Each Party hereto understands the effect of a general release and fully intends that the Release and Discharge, which is a part of this Settlement Agreement and Release, be specifically included herein. Each Party hereto voluntarily executed this Settlement Agreement and Release and did not do so under promise, duress, threat, or coercion of any kind.

8. GOVERNING LAW

This Settlement Agreement and Release shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.

9. ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS

The Parties agree to cooperate fully and execute any and all supplemental documents and to take all additional action, which may be necessary or appropriate, to give full force and effect to the terms and intent of this Settlement Agreement and Release, including the filing of dismissals with prejudice in the above-referenced action.

10. SURVIVAL OF THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT

It is agreed between APAC and the County that this Settlement Agreement and Release shall not alter or amend in any manner the force and effect of the original Contract, including warranties, express and implied.

11. EFFECTIVE DATE:

This Settlement Agreement and Release shall become effective and binding upon each of the Parties upon the date that it is executed by the last of the Parties to sign this Settlement Agreement and Release.
