## AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this <u>lst</u> day of <u>October</u>, 2003, by and between the County of Nassau, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the Northeast Florida Community Action Agency, whose address is Post Office Box 52025, Jacksonville, FL 32201, hereinafter referred to as AGENCY.

## WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that the AGENCY continue, and work with the economically deprived citizens of Nassau County, and

WHEREAS, the AGENCY now maintains services for the economically deprived residents of Nassau County;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. For and in consideration of the sum of \$5,000, which shall be paid in quarterly installments, during the months of November, February, May and August of the fiscal year, the AGENCY does hereby agree to perform services that will benefit the residents of Nassau County. Said services to include but not be limited to the following:

- a. Continuing the present level of services provided for the citizens of Nassau County.
- 2. The AGENCY shall make their financial records available to the COUNTY for purposes of an audit, if requested by the COUNTY. The COUNTY shall require an audit of previous year's financial records to be performed by an independent accounting firm. The audit report must be received by the COUNTY before the May distribution will be made.

3. All facilities, programs and services shall be compliant with the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Failure to provide facilities, programs, or services that are compliant with both the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) shall be considered a breach of the contract.
