FOURTH AMENDMENT

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into between the State of Florida Department of Children and Families, hereinafter referred to as the "department" and <u>Nassau County Board of County</u> <u>Commissioners</u>, hereinafter referred to as the "provider".

The department wishes to amend contract DJ992 entered into between said parties on <u>March 1, 2004</u>, for the period <u>March 1, 2004</u> through <u>February 28, 2009</u> and last amended on <u>May 03, 2005</u>. The purpose of this amendment is to replace Attachment II B, adjust funding, and make technical changes as follows:

I. Page 5, Standard Contract, Section I., Paragraph BB., PUR 1000 Form, is hereby added to read:

"BB. PUR 1000 Form

The PUR 1000 Form is hereby incorporated by reference. In the event of any conflict between the PUR 1000 Form, and any terms or conditions of this contract (including the department's Standard Contract), the terms or conditions of this contract shall take precedence over the PUR 1000 Form. However, if the conflicting terms or conditions in the PUR 1000 Form is required by any section of the Florida Statutes, the terms or conditions contained in the PUR 1000 Form shall take precedence."

II. Page 26, Attachment I, Section C., Method of Payment, Paragraph 1., line 11, FY 2005-2006 – Attachment II-B: <u>Subject to the availability of funds</u>, is hereby amended to read:

"FY 2005-2006 – Attachment II B: \$2,262,084.00"

III. Page 63, Attachment II B, Schedule of Funds FY 2005-2006 (Revised 11/10/04), is hereby deleted and a new page 63, Attachment II B, FY 2005-2006 Schedule of Funding Sources, Revised (09/23/2005), attached hereto, is hereby inserted in lieu thereof.

This amendment shall be effective on October 15, 2005 or the date signed by both parties, whichever is later.

All provisions in the contract and any attachments thereto in conflict with this amendment shall be and are hereby changed to conform to this amendment.

All provisions not in conflict with this amendment are still in effect and are to be performed at the level specified in the contract. This amendment and its attachment are hereby made a part of the contract.
