1. For and in consideration of the sum of \$42,527, which shall be paid in quarterly installments, during the months of November, February, May and August, the ARC/NASSAU program does hereby agree to perform services that will benefit the residents of Nassau County. Said services to include but not be limited to the following:

a. Continuing the present level of services provided for the ~~mentally retarded~~ ^{individuals with developmental disabilities} at the ARC/NASSAU'S main center.

2. The ARC/NASSAU program shall make their financial records available to the Clerk of the Courts on behalf of the COUNTY for purposes of an audit, if requested by the COUNTY or the Clerk. The COUNTY shall require an audit of previous fiscal year's financial records to be performed by an independent accounting firm. The audit report must be presented to the COUNTY and accepted by the Clerk of Courts before the May distribution will be made.

3. All facilities, programs and services shall be compliant with the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Failure to provide facilities, programs, and services that are compliant with both the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) shall be considered a breach of the contract.

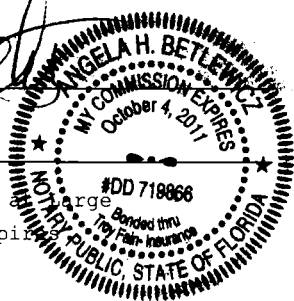
