THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this ~~November~~ <sup>13</sup> 9th day of ~~April 2007~~ <sup>2008</sup>, by and between the ~~COUNTY~~ <sup>COUNTY ATTORNEY</sup> of Nassau, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and the Nassau County Soil and Water Conservation District, whose address is Post Office Box 753, Callahan, Florida 32011, hereinafter referred to as the "DISTRICT".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, annually the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, covenants to budget and appropriate budget funds for the operation of the Nassau County Soil and Water Conservation District.


NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. For and in consideration of the sum of \$32,771.00, which shall be paid in quarterly installments during the months of November, February, May and August, the DISTRICT does hereby agree to perform services that will benefit the residents of Nassau County. Said services to include but not be limited to the following:
  - a. Continuing the present level of services provided for the residents of Nassau County.
2. The DISTRICT shall make their financial records available to the COUNTY for purposes of an audit, if requested by the COUNTY. The COUNTY shall require an audit of previous year's financial records to be performed by an independent accounting firm. The audit report must be presented to the COUNTY before the May distribution will be made.
3. All facilities, programs, and services should be compliant with the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Failure to provide facilities, programs, and services that are compliant with both the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal

Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) shall be considered a breach of contract.


