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AGREEMENT

COUNTY ATTORNEY

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 9th day of January, 2008, 2007, by and between the County of Nassau, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the Nassau County Council on Aging, hereinafter referred to as COUNCIL.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that there be a Council on Aging, and

WHEREAS, the COUNCIL provides many services for the aging residents of Nassau County;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. For and in consideration of the sum of \$270,916.00, which shall be paid in quarterly installments, during the month of November, February, May and August, the COUNCIL does hereby agree to perform services that will benefit the residents of Nassau County. Said services to include but not be limited to the following:
 - a. Continuing the present level of services provided for the aging at the COUNCIL'S main center.
2. The COUNCIL shall make their financial records available to the Clerk of the Courts on behalf of the COUNTY for purposes of an audit, if requested by the COUNTY or the Clerk. The COUNTY shall require an audit of previous fiscal year's financial records to be performed by an independent accounting firm. The audit report must be presented to the COUNTY and accepted by the Clerk of Courts before the May distribution will be made.
3. All facilities, programs and services shall be compliant with the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Failure to provide facilities, programs, and services that are compliant with both the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) shall be considered a breach of the contract.


