AMENDMENT NO. 2 / SECOND EXTENSION TO THE
AGREEMENT FOR CULVERT-POLYTHYLENE

THIS ADDENDUM entered into this ^{12th ~~4th~~ *BW*} day of August, 2009 by and between the **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA**, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, (hereinafter referred to as "County") and **FERGUSON WATERWORKS**, 9692 Florida Mining Boulevard, Jacksonville, Florida 32257, (hereinafter referred to as "Vendor").

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement dated November 8, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the original agreement provided for an initial term beginning November 8, 2006 and ending September 30, 2008, with an option to extend upon mutual contract between the vendor and the County; any extension of performance period under this provision shall be in one (1) year increments; and


WHEREAS, the parties extended the agreement for a renewal period commencing October 1, 2008 and ending September 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend and extend said Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. In accordance with Section 20 of the Agreement for Culvert-Polyethylene dated November 8, 2006, the performance period is hereby extended for an additional one (1) year beginning October 1, 2009 and ending September 30, 2010.
2. All other provisions of said Agreement not in conflict with this Addendum shall remain in full force and effect.
3. Time is of the essence.


