MAINTENANCE AND USE AGREEMENT BETWEEN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA AND AMELIA ISLAND PLANTATION COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC THIS MAINTENANCE AND USE AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 13thday of _January____ 2010, by and between BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (hereinafter the "County"), and AMELIA ISLAND PLANTATION COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC., (hereinafter "AIPCA").

WITNESSTH:

WHEREAS, the County owns land in Nassau County, Florida which land is located on Beach Walker Road, south of Canvasback Road situated between lots 10 and 11, which land is depicted on the printout from the Property Appraiser's website which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, AIPCA desires to have access to the portion of the above-referenced lands located adjacent to the pond (hereinafter the "Garden") and permission to landscape the area, construct pathways and sitting areas in the Garden for use of the community and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the County agrees to give AIPCA a revocable license to use the Garden for the above-stated purpose, subject to the conditions stated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, which shall be deemed an integral part of this Agreement and of the mutual covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth, the County and AIPCA, intending to be legally bound hereby agree as follows:

 County grants AIPCA a revocable license to access and use the Garden and to landscape and construct a sitting area, as depicted in the sketch which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

- 2. AIPCA agrees that no additional area shall be affected nor shall any other construction occur than that which is depicted in Exhibit "B" without the prior written approval of the Director of Nassau Amelia Utilities.
- AIPCA will not infringe upon or impair the use, rights and access of Nassau Amelia Utilities.
- 4. AIPCA will make no changes to the storm water drainage system now in place or any of the other utilities.
- County may revoke the license at any time by providing AIPCA ninety (90) days advance written notice of its revocation of the license.
- Upon notice by the County, AIPCA shall return the property to a condition acceptable by the County by removing any improvements deemed necessary by the County.
- AIPCA, in accepting this license, will indemnify the County from any damage resulting from their use of the site.
- 8. AIPCA further agrees to assume sole responsibility to ensure the Garden is maintained in a reasonably safe condition.
