**AMENDMENT NO. 1 / FIRST EXTENSION TO THE  
AGREEMENT FOR CENTERLINING AND THERMO PLASTIC**

THIS ADDENDUM entered into this 10th day of March, 2010 by and between the **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA**, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, (hereinafter referred to as "County") and **STRIPE THIS STRIPING COMPANY**, 710 Bowery Lane, Apartment C-23, Folkston, Georgia 31537, (hereinafter referred to as "Vendor").

**WHEREAS**, the parties entered into an Agreement dated October 22, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, the original agreement provided for an initial term beginning October 22, 2007 and ending September 30, 2009, with an option to extend upon mutual contract between the vendor and the County; any extension of performance period under this provision shall be in one (1) year increments; and


**WHEREAS**, the parties desire to amend and extend said Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION** of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:


1. In accordance with Section 20 of the Agreement for Centerlining & Thermo Plastic dated October 22, 2007, the performance period is hereby extended for an additional one (1) year beginning October 1, 2009 and ending September 30, 2010.
2. 4" Thermo-plastic shall be deleted from the pricing structure.
3. Stop bars shall be charged by length at the price for 24" thermoplastic instead of a unit price.
4. Thermoplastic pricing shall be revised as listed below:
  - i. 6" thermoplastic \$1.00 per foot
  - ii. 12" thermoplastic \$2.00 per foot
  - iii. 18" thermoplastic \$3.00 per foot
  - iv. 24" thermoplastic \$4.00 per foot
5. Mobilization fees shall be charged per job site. Multiple days on one job shall only include one mobilization fee. Several small jobs within close proximity shall only include one mobilization fee.
6. Vendor shall measure each road and provide cost estimate prior to purchase order being issued for work.
7. Invoices shall include invoice number, each date and time of service, name of road project, and each service provided.

8. Vendor shall wear a safety vest, lime green or orange in color, at all times while working on the roadways. Type 2 is acceptable for daytime hours and Type 3 is required for nighttime hours.
9. Vendor shall place signs indicating road work at both ends of the work area. Flashing lights are also recommended.
10. All other provisions of said Agreement not in conflict with this Addendum shall remain in full force and effect.
11. Time is of the essence.
