

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT**10 MAY -4 PM 1:35**

THIS INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT entered into this 12th day of May, 2010, by and between the NASSAU COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER'S OFFICE, a constitutional officer, hereinafter referred to as "APPRAISER", and the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "County".

WHEREAS, the Appraiser and the County have determined it to be in the best interests of the citizens of Nassau County to coordinate the efforts of the Appraiser and County in planning for development, implementation, and support of the Appraiser's Geographic Information System "GIS" Web site; and

WHEREAS, the Appraiser and County agree that the resulting GIS Web site service should integrate as a component of a County-wide "Enterprise" GIS service which should be accomplished as set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Enterprise GIS services will support the comprehensive land use plans, DRI, incorporated and unincorporated boundary maintenance requirements, and other planning efforts of both the Appraiser and the County; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned will encourage intergovernmental coordination to maximize the efficient use of resources; and


NOW, THEREFORE, the Appraiser and County agree as follows:

1. **GIS WORKSTATION CONFIGURATION** – The Appraiser will assist the County with the set up of existing ESRI GIS ArcView software configuration and connection to the Appraiser's primary geodatabase server through the resources of the Nassau County Board of County Commissioner's Technical Services Department hereinafter referred to as the "TSD".

2. **GIS SPATIAL DATA LAYERS** - The Appraiser will share with the County, the public information GIS spatial data layers currently being maintained or shared by the Appraiser's GIS service.
3. **CUSTOM WORK AND DELIVERABLES** - The Appraiser will assist in the maintenance of digital GIS coverage's of the County's comp plan, zoning and County limit boundaries based on the counties parcels. In addition the County will be able to overlay environmental data such as flood zones (FEMA), parcels, road networks, wetlands, storm surge, historic sites and many more types of critical data. The Appraiser will install, implement and build the County's initial custom map project files for the County to use as templates. The Appraiser will support the County with GIS services not to exceed 15 hours a week.
4. **WEB DELIVERED GIS SERVICES** – The Appraiser will build and host a web delivered interactive private and public GIS website. In addition the Appraiser will provide training and support for the GIS websites. In consideration for the aforementioned services, the County will compensate the Appraiser's GIS service in the form of a yearly fee of five thousand and no one hundred dollars (\$5,000.00).
5. **INITIAL GIS STARTUP SUPPORT** – GIS startup support services as outlined in subsections 1 – 4 above will be provided during a twelve months period beginning at the date of final execution of this interlocal agreement. Ongoing work beyond the scope of tasks outlined within sections 1 through 4 above will be provided at a fully allocated fee.


6. **SEVERABILITY** – If any section, clause, or provision of this Agreement is held invalid, the remainder of this Agreement shall be construed as not having contained said section, clause, or provision, and shall not be affected by said holding.
7. **NO AGENCY** – Nothing contained herein shall be construed to constitute either of the parties, nor any of its agents or employees, as the agent of the other.
8. **TERM** – This agreement shall take effect upon execution and shall terminate 1 year from date of execution.
9. **AUTHORITY** – Each of the parties represents to the other that the execution of this Agreement has been duly and properly authorized by the governing bodies of each of the parties, and each has full authority to execute the same through its representatives whose signatures appear below.
10. **FILING** - This Interlocal Agreement shall be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Nassau County, Florida, prior to its effective date, in accordance with Florida Statutes, 163.01 Florida Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1969.
