INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY MAINTENANCE

This Interlocal Agreement is entered into this <u>29th</u> day of <u>April</u>, 2013 (hereinafter referred to as the "Effective Date"), between **NASSAU COUNTY**, **FLORIDA**("Nassau County"), a political subdivision of the State of Florida and **CITY OF JACKSONVILLE**, **FLORIDA** ("Jacksonville"), a municipality located in Duval County, Florida (collectively referred to herein as the "Parties").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Jacksonville owns a three hundred twenty-six foot (326.00 ft.) portion of Motes Rd., a public road which is more specifically described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto (the "Road"), which requires maintenance and/or other improvements (the "Services"); and

WHEREAS, Nassau County has previously performed Services on the Road, for which it has not received compensation; and

WHEREAS, based on the lack of convenient access for which Jacksonville could perform maintenance, Jacksonville wishes to authorize Nassau County to continue to provide Services for the Road; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement establishes Nassau County's continued Services to the Road, and mandates that Nassau County will exclusively receive compensation for said Services; and

WHEREAS, the parties are authorized by section 171.203, Florida Statutes, to enter into an interlocal service boundary agreement of this nature.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:


- 1. <u>Services</u>. Nassau County shall provide maintenance and/or other improvements on the Road and shall only be required to perform Services to the Road as had been done historically. The Services included grading and other drainage and maintenance.
- 2. <u>Procedure for Services</u>. Nassau County shall grade the Road as it has done historically, and shall not be required to make any additional improvements to said Road.
- 3. <u>Compensation</u>. Nassau County is authorized to establish a reasonable fee for the Services, which fee shall be paid by any interested party on a per request basis, prior to Nassau County providing the Services for said period. In no event shall Jacksonville be required to pay such fee for the Services.

MOTES ROAD AS SHOWN ON MAP BOOK 8, PAGE 54 OF SAID NASSAU COUNTY AND THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE CONTINUE SOUTH 44-42"12" WEST, ALONG LAST SAID COUNTY LINE 29.60 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 68-15"03"
EAST, 428.67 FEET TO AN INTERSECTION WITH THE EASTERLY LINE OF SAID SECTION 29; THENCE NORTH 00"09"55" EAST, ALONG LAST SAID LINE 29.31 FEET TO AN INTERSECTION WITH A SOUTHEASTERLY PROLONGATION OF
AFORESAID NORTHEASTERLY RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF MOTES ROAD; THENCE NORTH 68-15"03" WEST, ALONG SAID SOUTHEASTERLY PROLONGATION 406.34 FEET TO AN INTERSECTION OF AFORESAID COUNTY LINE AND THE POINT
OF BEGINNING.



4. Nothing in this agreement shall create any responsibility on the part of Nassau County to enforce public accessibility to the roadway in question on the Duval County side of the county line.
