Jonathan,

Due to the constraints of the 6" utility strip between the curb and the front face of the sidewalk and the USPS mailbox installation criteria (see attached) the mailboxes were installed on the backside of the sidewalk. The Fernandina Beach Post Master, Steve Wyman, called me yesterday, very unhappy, regarding the locations of the mailboxes. Since the mail carrier must now exit the vehicle at each location they are concerned with safety and time allotments. I am scheduled to meet with him this Friday morning at 11:00 a.m. I believe I have a solution that will make him happy and keep the mailbox locations within the required USPS guidelines, however it will require us to relocate the mailboxes from where they are now. My thought is to install them in the 6" utility strip, but install them parallel to the roadway in lieu of perpendicular as depicted on the attached. The Post Master seemed to be okay with this, but we are going to look at everything in the field first.

I met with the Fernandina Beach Post Master, Mr. Steve Wyman, and the carrier Supervisor, Ms. Crystal Beardman, on Friday, March 29th to discuss placement of mailboxes on the east side of 14th Street.

During our discussions and site review it became apparent that many of the mailboxes will need to be relocated so the mail carrier does not have to exit the vehicle for delivery or drive up on the new sidewalk. I have come up with a solution which was agreed upon with the Post Master and I would like to meet with you onsite to discuss.

Mailbox Guidelines

So what makes a good mailbox?

From the wear and tear of daily use to constant assault from the elements, these guidelines will help you set up a mailbox that stands up to it all.

If you're buying a new mailbox, look for the Postmaster General's seal of approval; every new mailbox design should be reviewed and approved before it goes to market.

If you opt to construct your own mailbox, you should run your plans by your local postmaster. Overall, the mailbox you build will need to meet the same size, strength, and quality standards as manufactured boxes.

The house or apartment number should be clearly displayed on your mailbox. And, if your mailbox is on a different street than your house, the street name should appear on it, too.





Your local postmaster must approve the location of your mailbox.

Put a roadside mailbox where a carrier can reach inside without leaving the truck. That means positioning it about 41" to 45" off the ground and back about 6" to 8" from the curb.

If you live in the city and are attaching the box to your house, just make sure it can be accessed easily from your sidewalk, steps, or porch. Because city carriers often shoulder heavy bags, put your mailbox about 4' from the ground. That way, your carrier won't have to stretch or bend to reach it. And remember to keep the path to your mailbox clear in inclement weather.
