These rates will be used to modify the fee schedule for the Mobility Plan. The counts will be collected on a Monday through Friday at three facilities in order to collect site specific data.

Task 10 – Site Specific Traffic Counts -Sanctuaries

In conjunction with Task 9, the fee schedule with the Mobility Plan will be modified to consider the impact of removing church sanctuaries. The schedule will also be modified to remove private schools and consider the incentivizing of private and public day care facilities. The day care incentives will consider three levels of incentives that the Board of County Commissioner (BOCC) may choose from.

It is estimated that one additional Task Force meeting will be required as well as two (2) additional BOCC meetings will be required. This scope also addresses time spent for individual County Commissioner meetings and with County staff.
