Richard, give me a call to discuss when you get a moment. Since our last field meeting Kathy Thomas has concurred that this project is a RRR type project. She asked that I reach out to you and Mark to and Mark has said that if I can certify that the project meets with all RR criteria and you can live with the finished project then we can complete the certification and move on. Except for the two areas in question, (immediately adjacent to the MES at Ratliff and side drain under the second driveway), the constructed project does meet RRR criteria.

The two areas in question do not meet the RRR criteria that requires a front slope located outside the clear zone to be a minimum 3:1 slope(the existing front slopes at those two locations is 2:1). The only fix that would provide that 3:1 slope at those two locations would involve the removal of the MES at each location, skewing the pipe approximately 10 degrees away from the road and constructing a standard end wall. (Attached is a detail of how that would look)

The reason we did not propose this solution in the first place is that, although it technically meets RRR criteria, as the engineer of record I felt like a very small area of 2:1 front slope in conjunction with a mitered end section(all of which are outside of the clear zone) is significantly more recoverable and thus a much safer condition than a vertical face end wall.

So, what I would like to discuss with you is how you would like us to proceed. My proposed solution to utilize edge striping to better channel vehicles away from these areas is still, in my opinion the best solution. It does not technically meet RRR, as EOR I am willing to certify however needed that it is the safest solution that fits within the existing ROW.

Carrie, I had an excellent meeting on site with Jim Kahre on December 22nd where we reviewed and discussed his concerns. He had some valid concerns but after some discussion his two main issues seemed to me to be centered around the steep front slopes at the mitered end sections located at stations 18+00(northeastern Ratliff quadrant) and 21+80(southern end of gas station driveway). Although the ditches are relatively shallow and outside the clear zone, the front slopes at those two locations appear to be greater than 2:1. We discussed (and I agree) that a suitable "fix" to help channel motorists away from these two areas would be to stripe out returns at both of these locations – continue the edge striping around the northern return at Ratliff to connect to the Ratliff edge striping and add return striping to effectively make the gas station drive narrower(the current design calls for the striping to stop just short of the Ratliff return and continue across the gas station driveway). Although not typically done, striping these returns will cause no appreciable detrimental effects and will help keep motorists from driving on the shoulder to make these turns and direct them away from these two areas.

If we all need to meet to get this resolved then let us know what time is good and where and we will definitely be there. If possible, however I would like to have a little background relative to your concerns prior to the meeting so that I can better prepare and we can hopefully come to a resolution that we all can live with:

- 1. If you disagree with Carrie's assessment that this project was constructed substantially in accordance with the plans, it would help tremendously if you could provide us with a punch list of items to consider prior to the meeting if we concur with your assessment and agree to getting them fixed than we really don't need a meeting. If not we can still meet to develop an acceptable punch list and move on towards a resolution.
- 2. If you do feel like the project was constructed in accordance with the plans but are still do not feel comfortable that the project meets the Department's design criteria, then the issue is really related more to the permitted plans and not the construction of those plans and maybe you and I could discuss and hopefully come to some resolution. My contention is this project is a RRR project and that it was designed in accordance with all of the requirements set forth in the FDOT's PPM, volume 1 chapter 25 (Design Criteria for RRR) which specifically includes "adding turn lanes at an intersection" as one of the types of typical RRR projects. The applicable design criteria for a RRR project with a design speed of > 45mph that we followed are as follows:
 - a. Clear zone(CZ) is defined as 14' from the edge of the travel lane or 8' from the edge of a turn lane.
 - b. Front slopes of 1:6 are desired but 1:4 may be constructed in the CZ, existing 1:3 may remain in the CZ but may require shielding and 1:3 outside of the CZ may be constructed
 - c. Back slopes of 1:4 are desired but 1:3 may be constructed in the CZ, existing 1:2 may remain in the CZ but may require shielding and 1:2 outside of the CZ may be constructed
- 3. If the Department disagrees that this project is actually a RRR project then we really have some serious issues because in no way does our permitted construction documents meet the FDOT's PPM, volume 1 chapter 2 (Design and Geometrics Criteria) which are utilized for new or reconstruction type projects (the most obvious of which is the 1:6 or flatter slope inside the CZ (14' from the edge of a turn lane) requirement).

Please feel free to call me at the office (904)363-8460 or on my cell (904)891-0360 to discuss further. We will do whatever is necessary to correct any mistakes we may have made or to help rectify any other issues so that all parties are satisfied with this project.

I visited the site on Monday 12/20/10 and the ditch is unacceptable. We do not permit V-bottom ditch configurations and the ditch line does not run even to the mitered end sections. The current configuration will wash out during a heavy rain. Mr. Kahre is stating that the front slopes at the existing MES's will not be accepted due to them being slightly steeper than a 4:1. Per the EOR, this was expected since they are existing and they are outside of the recoverable terrain. These MES's are side drains and are located at the driveway entrances and on the SW corner of Ratliff Road. The stamped plans do not call for us to remove and replace these to different offsets. The longitudinal slopes (from the driveway to the top of the MES aprons will be at a 4:1. The area in question is only about 5' long.

I arrived at the site after you left... I noted the contractor has graded the shoulder slopes. I took readings along the ditch and found the shoulder slope is greater than 1:4. Basically we have 1: 3 slopes, (varies from 32 %—38 %), with steeper measurements around the MES's. I spoke to Ryan about the slope issue and he stated that sod is scheduled for Tuesday. I did mention that the sod will be installed on shoulder slopes that do not meet what is indicated in the approved plans.




