## WILDFIRE HAZARD MITIGATION AGREEMENT

ss. 590.01, 590.02, Florida Statutes

The Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Forestry (DOF) has established a program of wildland vegetative fuel treatment to be effected in and around communities and subdivisions in order to mitigate the risk of homes and property being damaged or destroyed by wildfire. The methods used for this program include prescribed burning, manual and mechanical fuel height reduction, fire line construction, use of herbicides, or a combination of these treatments in accordance with ss. 590.01, 590.02, F.S.

The	Landowner	or agent:

- (1) Grants DOF access to the land and authority to carry out the practices of this agreement for the purposes of wildfire hazard mitigation treatment.
- (2) Understands the work will consist of burning, mowing, grinding, chopping, cutting vegetative fuels, or use of herbicides to retard regrowth of treated areas on lands adjoining or in close proximity to a residential community known as Yulee
- (3) Understands the appearance of the work zone area will be altered, in that standing vegetation up to four inches in diameter may be treated. Limbs and/or stems on remaining standing trees may be damaged as work is performed.
- (4) Represents that the property being treated and located below, under this agreement, is owned in fee simple, or is in lawful possession of the landowner, and the property boundaries are marked correctly.



Dear Mr. Selby:

The Florida Division of Forestry is requesting permission to complete a hazardous fuel mitigation project on the county property located off Citizens Circle and Veterans Way, at the Nassau County Judicial Complex. Wildfire mitigation is a free service provided by the Florida Division of Forestry to assist landowners in reducing vegetative accumulations that might fuel a wildfire. The Division of Forestry received ARRA funds to purchase a low grounds pressure mower and hire an operator, just for this purpose. Both federal and state governments realize that the best way to prevent wildfires from staring and spreading, is to reduce vegetation in wildland/urban interface areas. When an area is mechanically treated, the flammable brush is mowed and mulched in place. This mulched debris will not readily ignite, making it much harder for a wildfire to start. The benefits of this mowing will last for several years and will come at no cost to the County. I have enclosed a wildfire hazard mitigation agreement that must be signed by the County before the mowing can proceed. If you have any questions or concerns, please call me at (904) 266-5014.
