


AGREEMENT

Re: Special Assessments for Beach Renourishment Capital Improvements in the South Amelia Island Shore Stabilization Municipal Service Benefit Unit

COMES NOW, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, and the NASSAU COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR, and hereby agree (1) the County Commission shall have until March 1, 2011 to adopt a resolution of intent to use the uniform method to collect non-ad valorem assessments as provided by section 197.3632, Florida Statutes; and (2) the parties will comply with the statutory requirements associated with the County's use of the uniform method to collect non-ad valorem assessments, with the County being responsible for the actual administrative and collection costs associated therewith, all as provided in section 197.3632, Florida Statutes.


