

**AMENDMENT NO. 3 / THIRD EXTENSION TO THE
AGREEMENT FOR DISASTER DEBRIS MONITORING SERVICES**

THIS ADDENDUM entered into this 6th day of September, 2017 by and between the **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA**, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, (hereinafter referred to as "County") and **O'Brien's Response Management, LLC**, 2929 East Imperial Highway, Suite 290, Brea, California 92821, (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor"), each of which may be referred to individually as "Party" or collectively as the "Parties".

WHEREAS, the parties entered into a Cooperative Purchasing Agreement dated August 21, 2013 for Disaster Debris Monitoring Services, piggybacking off of an Agreement with the City of Fernandina Beach, Florida, RFP #11-102; and

WHEREAS, the original agreement provided for an initial term of two (2) years beginning August 21, 2013 and ending August 21, 2015, with an option to extend for two (2) additional extensions of one (1) year each if agreed by both parties; and


WHEREAS, the parties allowed for a subsequent renewal period of August 22, 2015 through August 21, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend and extend said Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:


1. In accordance with Article 3 of the Cooperative Purchasing Agreement for Disaster Debris Monitoring Services dated August 21, 2013, the performance period is hereby extended for an additional one (1) year beginning August 22, 2017 and ending December 25, 2017.
2. All other provisions of said Agreement not in conflict with this Addendum shall remain in full force and effect.




