into 14th THIS AMENDMENT entered this dav of , 2018 by and between the BOARD OF COUNTY March COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, political a subdivision of the State of Florida, (hereinafter referred to as "County") and the YULEE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION, a Florida not-for-profit corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "Organization").

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement dated December 18, 2009, for the use of the County's sports field located at the Yulee Sports Complex; and

WHEREAS, the Parks Commission approved a motion to change the dates in the agreement for daylight savings time (minutes for meeting dated September 21, 2017, attached as Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, the County desires to amend the agreement to allow for the annual use of the entire Yulee Sports Complex area for "Government Day"; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend said Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1

- Section 4 shall be amended as follows: The parties agree that lights shall not be used for practices during the period of March 15<sup>th</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> through October 15<sup>th</sup> September 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 2. The County reserves the right to use the entire Yulee Sports Complex area annually for "Government Day". The County will notify the Organization at the end of each calendar year of the date the County will be using the complex for the following year.
- 3. All other provisions of said Agreement not in conflict with this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
