AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE AGREEMENT TO UTILIZE THE COUNTY'S SPORTS FIELD

AMENDMENT entered THIS into this 19th , 2018 by and between the BOARD OF COUNTY COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU subdivision of the State of Florida, (hereinafter referred to as "County") and the CALLAHAN ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION, a Florida not-for-profit corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "Organization").

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement dated December 18, 2009 for the use of the County's sports field located at the Kirsten M. Higginbotham Sports Complex; and

WHEREAS, the Parks Commission approved a motion to change the dates in the agreement for daylight savings time (minutes for meeting dated September 21, 2017, attached as Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend said Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Section 4 shall be amended as follows: The parties agree that lights shall not be used for practices during the period of March 15th 1st through October 15th.

2. All other provisions of said Agreement not in conflict with this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.

Introduction: Everyone introduced themselves.

- May 18, 2017 minutes approved 1st motion Jennifer Mickey, 2nd Stephen Sloan, All in Favor
- Old Business- proposed changes to the Parks agreement from the May 18th meeting have been pulled from the table. No further discussion.
- Welcome back Hilliard Football @
- Callahan Ball Park 16/17 Projects at Callahan Ball Park have been completed. A drainage engineering study is approved for next budget year 17/18, Billy will write up the specs as soon as the storm damage is cleaned up. Taco Pope in the planning department is working on a purchase for additional land adjunct to the current Ball Park property. We were not sure at the time if it is 20 or 40 acres.

 Stephen asked about lighting for the new pavilion, and also says that they can provide the ballast. Billy says if they can provide them, then the County can install them. CLL asked status of fields being mowed. The County advised that all staff has been tied up with storm preparation and that the regular mowing schedule should start back up this week. Leanne reported that they have a net that is tangled up, Suzle advised that we have a work order to untangle. Leanne advised that they still want lights, the Parks Department did ask for this in the budget but it was not approved, we will submit it again at mid-year. Leanne was advised to look into renting lights until a permanent resolution can be done and was encouraged to attend board meetings and make their need for lights known to the Board.
- 5. Yulee Ball Park Welcome to the new Little League President, Jennifer Mickey. The Gym project is approved for CIP, the lighting has already began, the doors/jambs, back boards and hoops are to be replaced, and the restrooms will be updated with new tile half-way up the walls, Billy discussed expenses for this. Catrina asked if the tollets will be replaced also, Billy advised that yes, if funding is available.

Tony advised that the Gym front porch roof may be sagging, Billy advised that He checked on this, and that it is built that way, and not sagging.

Timothy advised that He is looking to expand into the Spring Season under a different Liability/Organization. Tammy to provide him with a list of the documents that must be provided to the County, and that it would then have to be Board approved. Timothy also asked if it is in writing somewhere that they are allowed or not allowed to charge admission for games. Tammy will look into this and advise, Catrina with LL reports that the upstairs door to press box does not line up correctly and will not lock. Catrina also reported that the fencing on the major softball field is leaning. Billy says this is from the storm, and that the County will add to the County "emergency plan" to remove wind screening prior to a storm. Yulee asked if the County is going to paint the board room, they were advised that yes the County will paint the board room, as soon as storm damage repair is completed.

Hilliard Ball Park - Jody reported that they need lights in the Park in the area closest to Bav Road. savs that He has requested this several times, and a long time ago, and nothing has been done. Billy advised that we will check the status of this as soon as possible. Jody also advised that they need irrigation, need heads replaced and/or repaired and that this has also been requested several times. Jody also says that dollar weed is taking over the new sodding on the football field, Billy advised that we have the weed and feed in the shed and will treat the new sodding after a (3) month period per the manufactures instructions. Jody asked if the County can move the bleachers by the football field so that they face the football field Instead of the baseball field, Suzie to generate a work order for this. Jody asked if the County can leave the grass on the football field a little bit high until it gets rolled, Blily to advise the mowing crew.
