EXHIBIT A Scope of Services

Proposal for Professional Services – Contract No. CM2452 Work Authorization No. 3 Omni Hotel Manholes Replacement

Scope of Services

Task 1 Design and Coordination Service

- 3. <u>Final Documentation</u> Consultant shall make a final inspection to determine if the Project has been fully completed in substantial accordance with the Contract Documents and whether the contractor has fulfilled all of its obligations there under so that the Consultant may recommend approval, in writing, of final payment to the contractor. Additional services may be added to this contract during the course of work based on negotiated fees. These respective fees shall be determined jointly by the COUNTY staff and the Consultant. No work shall be undertaken on any additional service tasks without the written authorization of the COUNTY.

Fee

The total lump sum fee for the all services will be \$22,860.00 (Not-to-Exceed Limited Amount).

Payment

Payment terms will be in accordance with the 2017 Professional Services Agreement Contract # CM2452 (Miscellaneous Engineering Services for Nassau Amelia Utility).
