FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018/2019 FOR EPISCOPAL CHILDREN'S SERVICES, INC.

This agreement entered into this 12th day of Olcember, 2018, by and between the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the EPISCOPAL CHILDREN'S SERVICES, INC., 8443 Baymeadows Road, Suite 1, Jacksonville, FL 32256, hereinafter referred to as AGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that the AGENCY's program continue; and

WHEREAS, the AGENCY provides quality child care to Nassau County's low-income children and parents.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. For the sum of \$12,150.00, which shall be paid in quarterly installments, during the months of December, February, May and August, the AGENCY does hereby agree to perform services that will benefit the residents of Nassau County. Appropriation necessary for the funding of this Agreement beyond FY 2018/2019 shall be subject to the budget and appropriation by the COUNTY during the regular budget process. Said services to include but not be limited to the following:
- a. Continuing the present level of services provided for the economically deprived children and parents of Nassau County, Florida.



- 2. AGENCY shall submit simultaneously to the County Manager and the Clerk an annual accounting acceptable to the Clerk on or before May 1st of each fiscal year in which AGENCY received funding from the County. Additionally, AGENCY shall make its books available for inspection by a designee of the County upon reasonable notice. Failure of AGENCY to provide the annual accounting record by the time specified shall result in the revocation of granting of further funds and reimbursement of funds distributed during the year for which no report was submitted.
- 3. All facilities, programs and services should be compliant with the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Failure to provide facilities, programs, or services that are compliant with both the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) shall be considered a breach of the contract.
- 4. The term of this agreement shall commence October 1, 2018 and terminate September 30, 2019.
- 5. This Agreement shall be amended in writing from time to time by mutual consent of both parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the effective date of this Agreement shall be the date of its being signed by the Designee of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 12th day of December, 2018.
