## FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 FOR THE SALVATION ARMY

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that the SALVATION ARMY continue to work with the economically deprived citizens of Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, the SALVATION ARMY now maintains services for the economically deprived residents of Nassau County.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. For the sum of \$5,000.00, which shall be paid in quarterly installments, during the months of December, February, May and August of the fiscal year, the SALVATION ARMY does hereby agree to perform services that will benefit the residents of Nassau County. Appropriations necessary for the funding of this Agreement beyond FY 2019/2020 shall be subject to the budget and appropriation by the Board of County Commissioners during the regular budget process. Said services to include but not be limited to the following:

- a. Continuing the present level of services provided for the citizens of Nassau County.
- 2. SALVATION ARMY shall submit simultaneously to the County Manager and the Clerk an annual accounting record acceptable to the Clerk on or before May 1st of each fiscal year in which SALVATION ARMY received funding from the County. Additionally, SALVATION ARMY shall make its books available for inspection by a designee of the County upon reasonable notice. Failure of SALVATION ARMY to provide the annual accounting record by the time specified shall result in the revocation of granting of further funds and reimbursement of funds distributed during the year for which no report was submitted.
- 3. All facilities, programs and services shall be compliant with the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Failure to provide facilities, programs, and services that are compliant with both the Florida Accessibility Code and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) shall be considered a breach of the contract.
- 4. The term of this Agreement shall commence on October 1, 2019 and terminate on September 30, 2020.
- 5. This Agreement shall be amended in writing from time to time by mutual consent of both parties.
